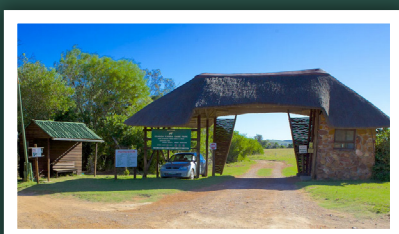

situated in the Cape Recife Nature, (20 minutes from PEGC) . SANCCOB is a registered non-profit organisation whose primary objective is to reverse the decline of seabird populations through the rescue, rehabilitation and release of ill, injured, abandoned and oiled seabirds – especially critically endangered species like the African Penguin. During the 1,5 to 2 hour “in depth and behind the scenes tour” , the ladies will be shown around the fantastic facility used to rehabilitate sea birds. They will be taken behind the scenes and meet the staff while they carry out their duties. Muffins, scones and water will be provided. A light lunch can be arranged for after the tour at own cost.
